

GRID-SCALE BATTERY PROJECT PROPOSED FOR YOUR COMMUNITY

We wish to inform you of an exciting new Grid-Scale Battery Facility being proposed in your community. The proposed site is located on Spider Lake Road, near our existing substation.

This location was chosen because of its proximity to existing transmission infrastructure. Planning work is currently in progress with proposed construction activity starting in 2024 and continuing through 2026.

We know that a mix of energy solutions is needed to get Nova Scotia off coal and reach 80% renewables by 2030. Grid-scale battery projects, like the one being proposed in the area, will enable more renewables to be introduced to the grid and continue to support reliability for customers.
